Strasbourg Overview

Strasbourg is the seat of several European institutions. Strasbourg is an important centre of manufacturing and engineering, as well as of road, rail, and river communications.

The best time to visit Strasbourg is in the spring or autumn, when temperatures are fairly mild, rainfall is lower and crowd levels aren't so brutal.

Currency:

The Euro (EUR) is the official currency in Strasbourg, France. Currency can be exchanged at banks, bureaux de change and some large hotels. Major credit cards are widely accepted.

1.00 GBP = 1.13 EUR
1.00 USD = 0.69 EUR

Note: These currency exchange rates are not updated daily and should be used as a guideline only.

Hotels

Hotel prices in Strasbourg must include VAT on the cost of the room and accommodation tax per person per night.

The hotels in Strasbourg have been grouped into four different pricing categories:

Category 4 - Over €180
Category 3 - From €140 to €180
Category 2 - From €100 to €130
Category 1 - Up to €100

These prices are the starting prices for a double room, including VAT and room tax but excluding breakfast unless otherwise specified.

Restaurants

The restaurants in Strasbourg have been grouped into four different pricing categories:

Category 4 - Over €100
Category 3 - From €70 to €100
Category 2 - From €40 to €70
Category 1 - Under €40

These prices are for an average three-course meal for one, including tax and service, and half a bottle of house wine or equivalent.

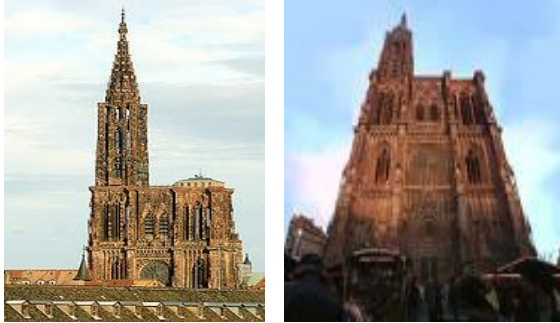

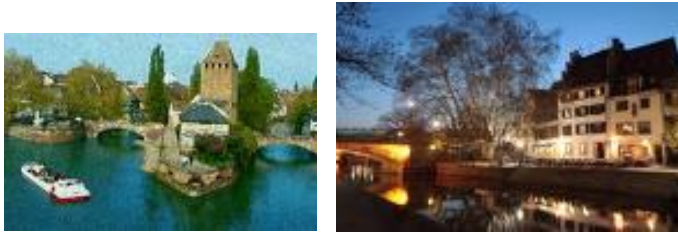

NIGHTLIFE

The student population keeps Strasbourg's nightlife vibrant. Many of the regular hotspots are clustered around the cathedral and along rue des Juifs, however, it is worth considering other options - such as an evening tour on a bateau-mouche (pleasure boat) or the son et lumière (lights show) performances at the cathedral in the summer.

SHOPPING

Strasbourg overflows with antiques shops, artisans, craftspeople, and beer makers. Every well-accessorized home in Alsace owns some of the napkins, aprons, tablecloths, and tea and bath towels of the Beauvillé textile mills.
